

## **JCUA Congregation Partner Network Get Out the Vote Pledge**

*Leading up to the Chicago municipal elections on February 26th, we invite our congregation partners to commit to JCUA's **Get Out the Vote Pledge**.*

### **In signing this pledge, your congregation commits to:**

1. Sharing resources on voter registration with your congregation, beginning February 11th (at the latest) until election day (February 26th).
2. Sharing resources on polling locations, early voting, and vote-by-mail, beginning February 11th (at the latest) until election day (February 26th).
3. Urging congregants to vote in this election from the pulpit during the Shabbat of February 15-16 and/or the Shabbat of February 22-23.

JCUA is able to provide a number of resources to support you in informing your congregation about the upcoming municipal elections, including:

- Voter guides for Aldermanic candidates based on our issue campaign work
- Information about voter registration
- Information about early voting, vote-by-mail, and polling locations
- Talking points for speeches or d'vrei Torah that speak to voting and voter engagement
- A JCUA staff person or leader to come and table or speak about civic engagement at an upcoming congregation event, including a Shabbat service

This upcoming election is crucial in our fight for a more just city. It is an opportunity to ensure our elected officials share our values and are accountable to Chicago's communities. We look forward to working with our Congregation Partner Network to have strong voter turnout from the Jewish community on February 26th.
