Key Dates:

Jan 29: deadline for mail-in registration; early voting begins at 175 W Washington

Feb 10: deadline for online voter registration

Feb 11: early voting begins at 50 sites citywide

Feb 21: deadline to request a mail-in ballot

Feb 26: general election

April 2: run-off election

Early Voting

Any registered voter may vote by mail.

On Election Day in your precinct

Election Day is Tuesday, February 26, 2019. Polls open at 6:00 am and close at 7:00 pm. *As long as you are in line by 7pm, the polls must stay open until you have voted.*
